MONDAY, 8 APRIL

9:30 am - 10:00 am Welcome from the Lady Chief Justice

Guests are invited to join the lawyers for a welcome at the Royal Courts of Justice, including a private audience with the first ever Lady Chief Justice, Dame Sue Carr – the most senior judge for England and Wales.

2:45 pm - 5:00 pm It's Tea Time!

11:00 am – 12:00 pm – Scenic drive through Pewsey Valley

12:00 pm – 2:00 pm – Lunch and Avebury Stone Circle

We will start with lunch at The Red Lion Pub. And then enjoy a private tour of Avebury Stone Circle. Avebury is a world heritage site for its outstanding Neolithic and Bronze Age monuments, including the largest prehistoric stone circle.

We should arrive back in London around 4:00 pm. Your evening is free.

For the Closing Dinner in the House of Lords within the Palace of Westminster, buses will depart The May Fair Hotel at **6:00 pm sharp.
